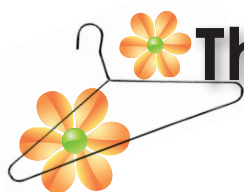

# The Rotary Young Designer of the Year Competition 2012



## "The Fragrance of Flowers"



The Rotary River Festival will be the scene where you will be able to showcase your fashion creations.

The garments will be modeled on the stage in front of the judges and the Festival Audience.

### Event takes place on the 3rd of March 2012.

Select ONE of the following categories:

#### 1. Primary school pupils

#### 2. Secondary school pupils

These two categories (1 & 2) will de-construct (meaning cut, patch, join, stick, glue, paint, bead, add material, decoration, etc) to any existing garments to create a brand new look/garment representative of the theme.

#### 3. School leavers younger than 30 years, NON-qualified, with no professional training.

#### 4. School leavers younger than 30 years, still in training (1st, 2nd, 3rd year students)

#### 5. School leavers younger than 30 years, who are qualified designers, with professional training.

These three categories (3, 4, & 5) should create a unique constructed garment, representative of the theme.

All of the above categories will be judged on professional presentation, comfort, quality, creativity, flair and innovation.



### How to enter -

Complete entry form on reverse. Enter your design by means of an A3 storyboard (consisting of a pose with garment, technical detail, fabric swatch and description).

Also include a short motivation (approx 100 words) of your inspiration for the design.

If selected, designers should provide their own model, or alternatively, model the garment themselves.

There is no size specification. On the judging day, ensure that the model is professionally presented/styled with appropriate accessories, hair, make-up as this will impact on overall success of your design.

There is a R20.00 entr ee fee per design entry, you may enter as many designs as you wish, each at R20.00.

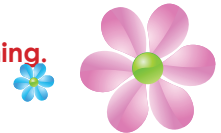

### RULES AND CRITERIA:

1.The Rotary Young Dress Designer of the Year Competition is only open to those studying and / or living in Sedibeng, Free State and Northwest. 2. There is no size specification for any of the categories 3. Deadline for the Entry Form, Storyboards & the garment (including accessories) is the 24 February 2012. These need to be handed in at Stonehaven on Vaal by the latest 7pm on this date and you will be issued with a receipt to confirm we have received your. Entry Form & Storyboard. If you are not sure of what details need to be included in the Storyboard – there is an example of one at Stonehaven on Vaal on display. 4.All entries will be showcased at the festival. The garments need to be labeled with your name and contact details. 5.Judging Criteria:- Creativity, flair, uniqueness, desirability to purchase, finish, quality of the garment and comfort to wear. 6.All entrants will receive a certificate and an individual evaluation by the Judges where they highlight your strong points in the design and if applicable give constructive advice and criticism in the areas you need to work on in the future in order to reach your potential.7.The Organizers do not take responsibility for any loss of item(s) or damaged item(s) during the Competition.8.All music will be supplied by the Organisers. 9.No late entries will be accepted. 10.All Designers need to be present at the Finals on the 3rd of March 2012 11. If you do not arrive on time for the Finals, the program will proceed without your creation and will thus be omitted and no longer eligible for the Competition.12.The Finalists will have an opportunity to market themselves to the public, by having their names and contact details placed in a program which will be given out to all those watching the show on the day. This will enable the public to contact you for a quote fro designing an outfit for them, if they like what you have designed at the Show. You need to indicate on the application if you would like your marketing contact details to be included on the program.13. The judges decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.14.Garments and accessories can be collected backstage after the Winners have been chosen on 3<sup>rd</sup> March 2012
